

Mission: DEEP SEA

BIG IDEA: My Faith Grows Deeper When I Use My Gifts!

BIBLE LESSON: Luke/John – Jesus Feeds the Multitude

<u>GAME</u>: Trivia Maker – Moses Leads the Israelites out of Egypt (Day 1 Review)

CRAFT: Snack Basket

Materials:

- 2 Paper Plates (cheaper the better)
- Scissors
- Brown Crayon
- Tape or Stapler
- Snacks (Goldfish and Wheat Thins)
- Marker

Instructions:

- 1. Put the 2 plates together and cut out HALF of the center circle.
- 2. Remove the Crayon paper from the brown crayon and lay it onto the plate.
- Use a textured area (basket, carpet, woven place mat) and shade in the plate. (Be sure to use the side of the brown crayon.) When sandwiched together, a pouch is created to carry things in.
- 4. With a crayon or marker -markers works best on one of the plates, write, "When Jesus feeds me"
- 5. On the second plate, write "My gifts grow"
- Once both Plates are covered with the texture crayon, staple (tape) along the bottom half of the basket. (NOTE: Close only to the opening of the basket.)
- 7. Fill the basket with "fish" (goldfish) and "loaves of Bread" (Wheat Thins).

PARENTAL TIP: Make Jesus come to life!! Allow your student to place 2 "fish" and 5 "loaves of bread" in their basket. Before they begin to eat their snack, have them exit the room (be creative/use your imagination) and YOU make them multiply by adding more "fish" and "loaves". Watch them light up with excitement!

EVANGELISM TIP: Have your child make a snack basket for neighbors or loved ones and allow them to "SHARE" their food like the young boy in our lesson!
