

ONSITE GATHERINGS GUIDELINES

PRE-REGISTRATIONS or providing your Contact Information on a **Visitor Sign-In Sheet** at the building entrance will be REQUIRED EACH WEEK for Worship Services. We recommend using this PRE-REGISTRATIONS system to speed up your entry into the building. You may make your PRE-REGISTRATION here online and use your confirmation email as your entry ticket to avoid having to wait at the entrance to provide your Contact Information on the **Visitor Sign-In Sheet**.

- Due to social distancing, seating capacity in the Downtown (740 MLK) Main Sanctuary and at the Olivet Nation (Hwy 58) location is dramatically reduced. Pre-registration helps us to determine when we're getting close to capacity and may need to make some adjustments.
- There will be no in-person Sunday School classes, in-person Youth Ministry nor nursery available until further notice.
- If you feel as though you are safer at home, please feel free to remain there.
- If you are at risk, or have had a fever, cough/sore throat, shortness of breath or have come in contact with anyone confirmed to have COVID-19, we are asking you to worship with us online.
- Before each service, a team of volunteers will be at work disinfecting contact surfaces in the church. Your cooperation with the following guidelines will greatly cut down on the amount of time and money spent in this endeavor.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE

- Face masks **are required at all times** while inside the building. If you must take off your mask for any reason, we ask that you step outside to do so.
- Hand sanitizer will be placed prominently at the building entrances and sanctuary entrance and exit.
- For our 740 MLK location, the North Narthex and South Narthex entrances will remain closed. You will be directed to enter the doors located in the church's rear parking lot.
- Please observe the social distancing seating arrangements based on the signage and tape on seats and seat rows.
- Please avoid all physical contact between non-family members.
- The water fountains won't be available.

WHEN YOU LEAVE

- When Worship Service ends, please allow Bishop Adams to depart first without delay and to allow him to maintain social distancing.
- Typically, ushers will dismiss the congregation row by row, to help maintain social distancing. You are welcome to fellowship outside the building at an appropriate distance. Please proceed outside immediately following the Worship Service.

We know it's a lot to take in, and we know our gatherings will continue to be different during this pandemic. However, these guidelines will allow us to ensure that everyone is safe and hopefully speed up the timeline in being able to return to a more "normal" environment for onsite gatherings.
